Description

Landucci".Circa 1920Dimensions:Height 36 cmWidth 44 cmDepth 30 cmSculpted from exquisite white marble, this work by Leilio Landucci captures a moment of tender complicity between two young naked children, seated on a rock, absorbed in the innocent play of a bird's nest placed beside them. The subtle realism of the child's flesh, the delicate treatment of the curls and gestures, and the softness of the expressions give the scene a touching and timeless poetry.Landucci, a sculptor active in the late 19th century, adheres to the neoclassical tradition while incorporating a naturalist sensibility. His art celebrates the purity of childhood and the beauty of the present moment through a balanced and graceful composition. The contrast between the
