Rare white earthenware Masonic plate with black decoration, made for the "La Charité" lodge, identifiable by the central inscription and the richly detailed emblematic symbolism. This piece most likely dates from the mid to late 19th century. Description: In the center is a set of Masonic symbols: Six-pointed stars arranged in an arc, Level, set square, mallet, acacia branch, And in the center, the words: "R..L.. La Charité, O... de Charleroi" (meaning "Respectable Lodge La Charité, Orient de Charleroi"). The peripheral inscription "LA CHARITÉ" reinforces the initiatory origin of the object. Mark on the reverse Plate from the Manufacture Impériale et Royale, a Belgian factory active in the 19th century, known for its production of fine earthenware with printed decoration, here marked for export or
