



Stoneware Vase By Roger Guérin



Description

Magnificent vase by the renowned Belgian ceramist Roger Guérin (1896-1954), originally from Bouffioulx. This elegant vase is fashioned from grès (high-fired sandstone) and features a characteristic dripping glaze in deep shades of blue, gray, and black, with a subtle metallic sheen. The piece perfectly illustrates Guérin's craftsmanship: a remarkable balance between form, texture, and glaze. Roger Guérin is considered one of the most important Belgian ceramists of the Art Deco and interwar periods.
