Virtue Dagger - 19th century - Steel, horn and leather scabbard. Rare 19th century virtue dagger, probably of French manufacture. Originally used as a symbolic defensive object or clothing accessory, it embodies the chivalric and moral ideal of purity and self-control. Description: The triangular blade is made of polished steel, with a diamond-shaped section, well balanced and tapered. The straight metal guard protects a finely turned black horn handle, mounted with metal rivets and finished with bone or ivory trim. It comes with its original brown leather scabbard, reinforced with a brass tip. Characteristics: Period: circa 1850-1880 Total length: 22 cm Materials: steel, horn, bone or ivory, leather, brass Origin: France or Belgium Condition: Very good general condition, intact blade,
