Andreas Gyula Bubarnik (Hungarian 1936-2010) Still Life of an ivory tankard, wine glasses, lemon, grapes, and strawberries, oil on wood panel, apparently unsigned (unexamined out of frame), mounted in a gilt moulded composition frame.We rate this artist extremely highly, as good as or even better than many of the 17th-century Dutch still life painters of the "Golden Age" who were his inspiration.
