In a carved and gilded wooden frame "à la Bérain" early 18th. The colors have remained bright and pleasant, small old restorations have slightly faded in the lower right part, see photos of details (without real importance) All stretched on a wooden frame protected by a light old cotton canvas. Very pretty panel in good condition with original colors with a pretty frame and its 18th hook.
