Description

Charming watercolor enhanced with pencil, depicting a castle reflected in the water of a lake. The brushstrokes are atmospheric, capturing the ambient humidity. The blue sky appears above the clouds. The work is clean, without foxing or tears. It is signed in the center right. It is placed under a mat and glass, surrounded by a simple modern black rod. This work was created by Louis Ageron, a famous watercolorist from Valence (Drôme), the city where he was born in 1865. Louis Ageron trained in painting at the Beaux-Arts in Lyon and then in Paris. He then returned to Valence, where he became director of the city's art school. Halfway between Impressionism and Symbolism--sometimes bordering on abstraction--Louis Ageron's work is readily in line with that of François-Auguste
