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| Description |
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Very beautiful solid walnut wardrobe from the end of the 17th - beginning of the 18th century, harmoniously proportioned, the rarity of this piece of furniture lies in its small size and its four-leaf opening. Our small wardrobe therefore opens on the front with four leaves distributed in two rows, two small drawers in the lower part complete the opening; Each door is carved with four triangular motifs in each of the angles, these frame a central diamond-shaped motif, all with heavily molded contours. The two sides are two-paneled, they are also worked and have the same motifs and moldings as the doors. This piece of furniture has been restored, the shelves, locks and keyholes were certainly changed in the middle of the 20th century. An older repair of use was carried out on the back of our piece of

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furniture at the level of the feet and its low rear crosspiece. This piece of furniture is in perfect condition, solid and presenting a very beautiful patina. Its small size makes it easy to position it in an interior.
