In coeval frameIn the second: pomegranates, thistles, grapes, apples, citrus fruits, figs, mushrooms, a basket of chestnuts and a sparrow. In coeval frameThese captivating compositions were the result of imagination, regulated however by a precise illustrative rigour. The fruits and vegetables were ordered in small piles or collected in plates and
