Description

This intimate work by Ghent painter Fritz Van Loo captures a woodland scene near Meudon, a region southwest of Paris beloved by artists in search of lush natural settings. Van Loo, a Flemish post-impressionist with ties to the Latem School, presents here a serene composition of trees, light, and silence. The warm brushwork, transparent hues, and delicate structure of the foliage reveal his technical mastery. The house, half hidden between tree trunks, anchors the composition and invites quiet contemplation. The painting is a testament to Van Loo's ability to distill calm and poetry from nature. A gem from his mature period that speaks to both eye and soul.
