Adrien Gaudéz was a talented sculptor known for his figurative bronze works, including monuments and busts. Trained at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, he exhibited regularly at the Paris Salons from 1864. His style evolved from classical motifs to incorporate the flowing, curvilinear forms of Art Nouveau. Notably, after being a prisoner of war in 1870, he

created a memorial honoring fallen French soldiers in 1892.
