Macnee was a leading Scottish portrait He studied under portraitist and landscapist John Knox.

Macnee continued his studies at the Trustees' Academy and in 1829 was admitted to the Royal Scottish Academy. He returned to Glasgow, where he established a flourishing portrait studio.

His sitters included wealthy merchants, pioneering industrialists, aristocrats and even Queen Victoria. In 1876 he returned to Edinburgh, was elected President of the Royal Scottish Academy and was knighted. The painting being offered is a beautiful example of the painter's work and is highly tactile. The colours are distinctive and the tonality is lovely.
