It is signed Durieux, perhaps Joseph Durieux (1877-1954) or René Durieux (1892-1952).At harvest time, a young woman indulges in a moment of theatrical tasting during a grape picking session. Perched on a low wall surrounded by trellises laden with ripe fruit, our model is about to savor a bunch of grapes that she holds up with her outstretched hand above her half-open mouth. Her elongated and unstable posture has the effect of further revealing her neckline and revealing the bottom of her slender
