In these weeks of spring, a young woman abandons herself to a moment of communion rediscovered with nature. If her eyes are closed, her lips stretched forward part at the approach of curious butterflies that flutter randomly across the meadow. The setting is bucolic when the young woman's attire is neat and refined with her high-waisted yellow dress adorned with puffed sleeves, her elegantly held
