



Bordeaux Chest Of Drawers From The Louis XV Period, 18th Century

Curved mahogany chest of drawers with 4 drawers on the front carved with 3 scrolled cartouches on three rows, with scrolled feet, and topped with period marble. The locks and handles decorated with acanthus are also in gilded bronze, are slightly posterior. Slight scratches from use on the top. From the 18th century. Very good general condition. Dimensions: Height: 87 cm Width: 141 cm Depth: 62.5 cm The Bordeaux chest of drawers is easily recognizable by its rounded tomb-like shape. The front and the uprights form a characteristic curved S-shaped line. Its style is inspired by the Regency and Louis XV without excess. As with the majority of port furniture, the structure is made of solid mahogany. The many shipwrights used this exotic wood imported from the colonies and used in
