A snowy atmosphere rather rare in Honfleur which brings a lot of charm to this painting, all the credit going to the painter who had the reflex to put down his easel to capture the moment and make it immortal. A painting of large dimensions 1 m 30 x 89 cm, makes us dive into this surprising moment. We guess a touch of cubism through the lines of the characters. Good mastery of colors. The painting is signed lower right Henriette Le Pesqueux French artist born in 1909. She was a student of the Beaux-Arts of Paris. She painted landscapes, notably views of the port of Honfleur and landscapes of Normandy. In 1950 she left to work as an art teacher in Madagascar then in Morocco and Algeria.
