Description

Motorcycle in Motion - Futurist Bronze,
1910s-1920 Gild bronze on wood base. Circa
1910. Probably Italian. Unsigned. 40cm 16cm
22cm high. This rare bronze sculpture from the
1910s or 1920s depicts a motorcycle in motion --
an exceptionally uncommon subject in sculpture
of the time. Beyond its rarity, the piece is firmly
rooted in the spirit of Italian Futurism, the
avant-garde movement that emerged in the early
20th century to celebrate speed, dynamism, and
the mechanical age. With angular forms, sweeping
curves, and a dynamic sense of propulsion, the
sculpture conveys not just the appearance but the
sensation of movement and mechanical energy.
Its rhythm and structure echo the aesthetic of
Futurist painting, and particularly recall the
treatment of similar themes in the works of Ugo

Gianattasio and Mario Sironi, who likewise explored modern machinery and urban motion through fragmented form and kinetic tension. Futurist bronzes are extremely rare on the market, due to their experimental nature and limited production. This piece stands out not only for its subject -- the motorcycle, a powerful symbol of modernity and freedom -- but also for its deep resonance with one of the most revolutionary artistic movements of the 20th century. A truly exceptional work, combining historical importance with striking visual impact.
