It is equipped with three measuring devices, a prism, and a bulb lamp. Approximate dimensions: Maximum width: 60 cm Height: 42 cm (lamp: 57 cm) Used condition, but generally good. A spectroscope is an instrument for measuring the intensity of light--specifically, the amount of light absorbed or transmitted by a sample--at different wavelengths.
