This meditative landscape demonstrates the quest for the senses, the communion with nature uniting pure and vivid colors, in a decorative and symbolic reading. Delicately colored bands in flat areas establishing different planes of perspective with serpentine lines and arabesques intertwine to form a graphic design with details serving to keep only the essential. This repertoire of forms is deployed in his works where the influence of the Nabis is evident. For this artist, nature represents

Alain Lansalot: between land and sea, Bordeaux artist trained at the Beaux-Arts, he fell in love with Brittany and settled there. The surroundings of the Quiberon peninsula are a real magnet for the artist, as soon as the weather conditions allow it, he goes to the Wild Coast to paint its cliffs, or sit between two fishermen's crates and sketch the surrounding ports. His paintings are exhibited as far away as Paris and New York.
