Bronze mirror Tang dynasty (618-907) The back of the mirror is decorated with inscriptions on the eccentric circle. a frieze of birds surrounded by stylized flowers 4 lions surrounded by vines are represented in relief on the concentric circle. The handle is in the shape of a half sphere pierced in the center with a toad motif. These mirrors were signs of power and wealth in antiquity up to Japan. The bronze work of the Tang dynasty was of great finesse and the casting techniques very advanced. This context makes them precious objects Dimensions 10 x 10 cm
