Bronze Lamp Signed Victor Paillard. Total height 71cm. High quality bronze. Victor Paillard is the son of Charles Paillard, a small landowner, and Denise Louise Victoire de Chaumont. Staying with his sister Mrs. Baudin in By-Thomery (Seine-et-Marne), his artistic talents were noticed by the Count of Guzmán[Which one?], who sent him to Paris to perfect his skills. After a stint at the Royal Free School of Drawing and training as a chaser, he was a student of Jean-François Denière and a collaborator of Ferdinand Barbedienne. Quickly recognized as one of the best bronze founders of his time, he created around 1830 a house of art objects and furnishings which would employ up to a hundred people in the mid-19th century. He received numerous official commissions, notably for the
