Staurotheque Icon with Cross, Gilded BronzeRussia circa 1820The cross is gilded bronze, with a classical cross in the middle surroundedby themes of Orthodox Church feast days. The bronze is preserved in superb quality, as is the entire icon. The icon frames the cross, with the four Evangelists in halos depicted in the four corners, and the sun and moon on the cross. The following subjects are depicted from top left to bottom right:First rowThe Descent from the Cross and the Entombment of ChristSecond rowThe Washing of Christ's Feet and the Last SupperThird rowSaints John, Saint Gregory, Saint Simon and Saint Charalampius, Saint Constantine, and Saint Nikita, all saints in the middle.Fourth RowThe Virgin of the Sign and the PietàIn the bottom row, an exceptional
