The perch paddle is mainly used to push the canoe through the sometimes cluttered meanders of the Sepik River. This curved shape of the blade prevents the end from getting stuck in the mud. Wood and paint remnants. Sold with a base. Approx. 235 x 15 cm / EUR380 base and shipping included.
