In the New Testament, only the text of John (IV, 1-30) recounts the episode of the meeting of Jesus and the Samaritan woman. According to the tradition of Orthodox Christianity, this woman is called Photina the Samaritan. As Jesus, resting near a well on his return to Galilee, asks her for a drink, the Samaritan woman is surprised that he, a Jew, dares to ask her for water: the Jews despised the Samaritans and did not speak to them. Jesus replies that the water she draws does not quench thirst, but that the living water he gives becomes gushing forth and that whoever drinks from it will never thirst again. In keeping with tradition, this magnificent tapestry has undergone a thorough cleaning, the installation of a hand-sewn linen lining, and a careful inspection by our experts at the Galerie Lissier Artisan Workshop.
