Indigo-dyed cotton veil brocaded with geometric Mughal-inspired patterns in white and gold. The gold brocaded is made of gilded spun blades with a silk core. In new antique condition having retained its finish. Perfect for a curtain. Jamdani is a technique of weaving and brocading cotton threads on a handloom whose tradition dates back to the 17th century.
