Octagonal barrel with a rifled bore. The first half is marbled with gold edging. The second half is blued with two gold garlands. Dovetail-mounted front sight. Lightened six-chamber cylinder; blued finish with gold edging; marked in a hollow St. Etienne. Single and double action operation. Closed frame, entirely marbled and decorated with gold threads; monogrammed on one side (attributed to Gustave de Latour) and on the other with the coat of arms of the city of Saint Étienne. Double locking system of the cylinder axis. Opening of the access hatch to the mechanism by lowering the trigger guard. Oval cap, marbled and decorated with a gold thread. Ring of bail on stud. Very good condition. Walnut case, with brass escutcheon on the top. Interior lined with purple velvet; contains his cleaning rod and two boxes of Dealer
