## Description

Precious hinged tiger's eye box in silver vermeil, circa 1950 Elegant rectangular box whose exterior faces are all clad in carefully adjusted tiger's eye plaques, presenting a spectacular play of shimmering reflections. The upper face is cut from a rare specimen of tiger's eye veined with hematite threads, forming a dark network contrasting with the golden hues of the fibrous quartz. The visual effect is powerful, almost architectural, and testifies to a rigorous choice in the selection of stones. The interior of the box is entirely sheathed in agate with a crystalline texture, in light, slightly cloudy tones. The internal hinges are in solid gilded silver (vermeil), assayed 800 thousandths, hallmarked in an oval, without a visible goldsmith's signature. The whole forms a work of precious jewelry, typical

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of Italian or German creations of the 1950s-1970s, intended for a refined or collector's clientele. This box is distinguished by the precision of its assembly, the quality of the materials, and its impeccable state of preservation: no chips on the corners, perfectly functional hinges, impeccable polished finish.
