Large centerpiece bowl in solid silver by Bruckmann & Söhne, Germany, early 20th century Elegant centerpiece bowl in solid 925 thousandths silver, with a multi-lobed shape, evoking the petals of a lotus flower. The smooth and regular movement of the border, with twelve hollow lobes forming gadroons, gives the whole a floral and sculptural look. The decoration, entirely obtained by shaping and hammering, underlines the quality of mastered goldsmith work. The piece rests on a large circular stepped shower foot, ensuring balance and stability. It bears the 925 title hallmark accompanied by the goldsmith's mark of the famous house Bruckmann & Söhne, active in Heilbronn (Germany), one of the most important German goldsmith workshops of the late 19th and early
