### Description

German solid silver and cut crystal planter, circa 1890. Elegant table planter in 800 thousandths solid silver, mounted on a scalloped base and highlighted with a rich Rocaille-Louis XVI style decoration, finely embossed and chiseled. The openwork belt presents a motif of crosses adorned with flowers, while the smooth reserves alternate with panels finely decorated with stylized foliage. The whole is punctuated by a scalloped and molded border of great precision. The setting is completed by its interior in wheel-cut crystal, forming at the bottom a radiating star motif, typical of high-end productions of the late 19th century. Note a very discreet shine barely perceptible on one of the points of the crystal scalloping, reported here for accuracy but almost invisible to the naked eye. German title mark
