- Oil on canvas.- The force of meteorological phenomena and the superior sensation of the sublime merge in this powerfully romantic landscape. As in "Winterreise," the fragrant promise of spring seems both immediate and distant, and the allusions to a changing nature confuse the frozen and intrepid viewer.
