Description

Rare 9 mm pinfire revolver in triple actions after the invention of Eugène Lefaucheux, patented in 1862. The 3rd action allowed the hammer to be cocked by pressing the trigger; it was necessary to press it a second time to fire, which should have avoided finger strikes when firing, but the mechanism was complex and fragile with the fouling of the black powder. It jammed or broke quite easily. As a result, the patent was quickly abandoned. The other 2 more classic actions allowed one by pressing the trigger vigorously to engage the shot and the second by cocking the hammer by hand allowed to take aim before firing. Condition: Good general condition. The barrel grooves are present and in good condition. The mechanism is perfectly functional in its 3 actions. Shipping costs: France: EUR20 Europe:
