Square in shape with a lid, this sugar bowl is made of molded glass, called ouraline. That is to say, made with a uranium oxide during fusion, which gave the glass a dichroic luminosity between green and yellow playing with natural light, this offered a fascinating result, unfortunately, the fumes during manufacturing were extremely harmful and this practice was stopped and banned by decree. The thickness of the glass and the relief decoration are particularly flattering for this technique as you can see in the photos taken in natural light.
