As the title suggests, the atmospheric painting depicts a group of men and women in a scene of joyous pleasure. The bucolic, almost idealistic rural scenery forms the backdrop for what can only be described as a theatrical celebration of life and love. Looking closely at the work reveals a range of characters, each of whom is depicted in

Condition report: In good restored condition with fine areas of craquelure throughout most noticeable within a small area top right hand side.
