Description

This Rare and original Antique Tile Mural Panel depicting a Musical Scene was made in Portugal in the period of 1706-1750. Item Details & Specifics: The late 17th century and the early 18th century was considered to be the 'Golden Age of the Tile', the so-called Cycle of the Masters. Mass production was started not just because of a greater internal demand, but also because of very large orders from Brazil. Large one-off orders were replaced by the less expensive use of repetitive tile patterns. Churches, monasteries, palaces and even houses were covered inside and outside with tiles, many with exuberant Baroque elements.
