The composition depicts a pair of tropical fish, probably angel fish.It is made of glazed terracotta (majolica), with a matte finish and soft colors ranging from mother-of-pearl white to aqua green to touches of blue, gray and lilac.Cacciapuoti was one of the leading Italian manufactures of the early 20th century, founded in Naples by Giuseppe Cacciapuoti and later moved to Milan. Its works were in high demand both in Italy and abroad for their technical quality and decorative
