Maurice Georges Poncelet (1897-1978): "The Traveling Musicians", oil on canvas mounted on a 50 X 73 cm stretcher, without frame. In need of complete reattachment and with significant missing parts, dirty and annotated "study" and traces of signature. Near the resting donkey, a woman breastfeeds her child while turning towards a violinist in a pink leotard remembering Picasso... The Artist was contemporary with all the movements of Modern Art to which he contributed with canvases that were both colorful and muted in a touch that is reminiscent of many artists of the School of Paris such as Edmond Heuzé with whom he shared a taste for the circus or Dietz Edzard. Familiar with the Salons, he was always favored by collectors but his death in 1978 made him fall somewhat into oblivion and
