It opens with a molded door, revealing three fixed shelves and a drawer with a functional key lock. Ideal for storing linens, dishes, documents or even for use as an extra wardrobe, with the possible addition of a rod. On the door, the original lock is in perfect working order and retains its key, providing a refined and discreet detail. The projecting cornice, with its pure and well-proportioned lines, underlines the sober elegance of the whole. The piece of furniture rests on crow feet at the front and two straight legs at the back. The base is entirely made of solid wood,
