Description

Elegant armchair with a flat back, typical of the transition between the Louis XIV and Regency styles, distinguished by a finely carved walnut structure and period tapestry with floral decoration. The double-rolled console base is connected by a lively X-shaped crossbar, emphasizing the ornamental flexibility characteristic of the Regency style. The cuffed armrests are molded and beautifully curved, ending in scrolls. The scalloped belt harmoniously follows the lines of the base. The back and seat are covered with a petit point tapestry on a golden ochre background, representing a bouquet in a vase on a base, surrounded by polychrome frames with stylized foliage and scroll motifs. This armchair is a remarkable example of French furniture from the

beginning of the 18th century, combining the architectural rigor of the end of the reign of Louis XIV with the suppleness of forms foreshadowing the Louis XV style. The presence of its original tapestry, although patinated, gives it a rare authenticity sought after by collectors.
