Magnificent Cicim from Karapinar in Central Anatolia. Cicim, pronounced "djidjim" are woven and entirely embroidered pieces. Most old pieces like this one covered the walls of nomads' tents. Wool on wool. Vegetable dyes. The embroidery work is remarkable in finesse and precision. Another distinctive sign linked to its antiquity, the piece is composed of two panels joined and sewn together. Vegetable dyes.
