each different, in similar postures, supporting a jar chiseled on its

contour, from which spring the candlesticks

finely ornamented with

twists, scrolls and fleur-de-lis. Five-light

candlesticks whose candle

holders are equipped with original and removable

wax protection, at the

top rests a perfume burner as a damper. Marble
