Set of twelve 925 silver plates, Mexico, 1970s -18 cm size Superb set of twelve 925 sterling silver plates, made in Mexico in the 1970s. Measuring 18 cm in diameter, these pieces can be used as starter, dessert or bread plates, depending on the desired use. Their versatility makes them ideal for a refined presentation on a complete table. Each plate features exactly the same molded relief decoration as the large 28 cm plates, with a richly worked rim of stylized rocaille motifs, giving the set a uniform decorative elegance. They are therefore the perfect match for the set of ten large plates presented separately. The total weight of the set is 3.3 kg, a guarantee of quality and solidity. As with the main set, there are scratches from use, as well as some small surface alterations due to
