Translucent, colored, opaque or iridescent glass beads, ceramic beads and some hard stones.

Excavation patina. Remarkable artisanal work of qualitative drilling. Imagine the strength and mastery of the tools to drill hard stones and cut them, with the means of antiquity. Total length of the beads placed end to end along a string: 42 cm

Diameters of the beads: between 4 and 20 mm

Green central stone 20 x 16 x 6 cm
