Pair of covered salt cellars in solid silver, Louis XVI period. Oval in shape, the body is entirely openworked with cherubs holding floral garlands. In the center, there is a blank medallion. It rests on four feet. The domed lids are decorated with channels and gadroons ending in a seed. PARIS 1788. Silversmith: barely legible. Marks of charge, jurande, master silversmith and discharge on the bodies and lids. Blue glass interiors in perfect condition. Weight without the glasses: 134 gr.
