No signature, we have unframed the sheet. It is glued to the cardboard, so it is impossible to see the back which could have given us information. We are selling this beautiful gouache with the attribution to the Clérisseau school. Late 18th century period. Framed in pichpin rod and blackened fillets from the 19th century. Delivery by carrier between 2 wooden plates, 50 euros in France, 150 euros in the EU and 300 euros rest of the world.
