Description

Moving representation of Christ according to the iconography of the Ecce Homo, this painting features a Christ crowned with thorns, his hands tied and dressed in a red coat, symbol of the Passion. The face imprinted with softness and resignation, bathed in a subdued light, invites meditation. The work is part of the chiaroscuro tradition of the 17th century Italian school, in a style influenced by Caravaggio's darkness. The modeling of the body and the treatment of the drapes reveal a beautiful control of light. The composition, sober and frontal, accentuates the spiritual dimension of the subject. Also the restricted palette - dominated by deep browns and reds - contributes to the collected atmosphere of the scene.
