Description

A suite of three gouache and watercolor works depicting stops at an inn during a hunt, by the artist George Wright (1860-1942). Two signed lower right and one unsigned. Dimensions of each work: 11 cm x 14 cm. Framed dimensions: 27.5 cm x 68.5 cm. The works are in very good condition - the frame is in fair condition. Born near Leeds, England, in 1860, George Wright was the older brother of Gilbert Scott Wright. He is believed to have worked as an illustrator early in his career. He lived in Rugby, England, for two years, during which time he painted polo scenes; he then lived in Oxford and Richmond, Surrey. Upon his retirement in 1939, he settled in Seaford, Sussex. He was best known for his hunting and training scenes and for his portraits of horses and equines; he also painted historical
