Pair of rare gilt bronze candlesticks - First Empire periodHeight: 28 cmBase diameter: 12 cm?Elegant and highly symbolic, this pair of gilt bronze candlesticks embodies the spirit of the First Empire and pays a shining tribute to Napoleonic military glory. The shaft, remarkable for its composition, represents a bundle of crossed rifles, surmounted by unfurled flags, and supports a nozzle adorned with an inverted helmet with a plume of feathers - a rare and bold detail, evoking the splendors of the Imperial army. The whole rests on a finely worked circular base, an imitation of a mound strewn with grass and flowers, adorned with a laurel garland, symbol of victory. This work from the beginning of the 19th century, anchored in the style and codes of the First Empire, is aimed directly at
