## Description

Large cooling bucket, French Regence-Louis XV, metal formerly mercury silver-plated. Beautiful piece, bronze and brass; this period piece clearly shows its authenticity: we can distinguish thanks to some wear, the lateral brazed seam construction of body, joined to the circular seam of bottom. Pot-bellied Medici shape, resting on a round stepped foot, decorated of radiating gadroons, Pot-bellied body, surrounded by a strong fillet, then ringed of 4 fillets, wide flared border enriched with its crown of gadroons. Two strong handles, knotted. Condition: This bucket has been used, has suffered and shows the scars of old repairs, (red arrows), on upper edge, barely visible, and also a small blocked hole in foot. Therefore, we are sure that exterior silvering has been redone, it seems of good quality. Bottom
