Pair of stucco lion heads - 19th century

A striking pair of stucco ornamental elements,

depicting powerful lion heads in relief, dating back to the second half of the 19th century.

Each lion head, modelled with great expressiveness and attention to anatomical detail, emerges from a rectangular panel, suggesting an original use as a decorative architectural element - perhaps part of a boiserie, a monumental jamb or a scenographic furnishing.

Lions, a symbol of strength and protection, have often been depicted in art and architecture throughout history.

The stucco, now worn in some places, gives a pleasant patina of time that accentuates its
