Description

Moroccan Nimcha Saber - Morocco, 19th century. Horn handle, silver ferrule and steel guard with beautiful remains of gold damascening. European blade with half-moon and Santiago cross markings (markings generally attributed to Spanish furnishers but having very often been copied, notably in Solingen or Passau). Scabbard with wooden core covered with brown morocco and a chiseled silver rivet. Missing the rivet button above the pommel (however the blade and handle have no play). Slight accidents to the scabbard and rivet. Total length 100.5cm. Length without scabbard 98cm. Blade length 82cm.
